Scholarship

The Glenayre Scholarship Award is an annual award given to a graduating secondary school student recognizing volunteerism and community involvement. In 2018, the value of the scholarship is \$700.

Applicants must:

- Be a resident of the Glenayre neighbourhood in Port Moody, BC
- Be in their graduation year with graduation to occur by August 31 of this school year
- Be eligible for a B.C. Certificate of Graduation (Dogwood Diploma)

Submissions must include:

- a resume highlighting your appreciable history of volunteering
 - within the community of Glenayre, including for the Glenayre Community Association, and
 - within a broader community of Port Moody and beyond.
- Two letters of reference,
- A presentation specific to this scholarship, presenting details of your volunteer work or community involvement, what led you to it and what you've learned from it. The presentation must be in the form of either a written statement, maximum 500 words, or the URL to view an online video presentation, maximum 5 minutes.
