

RS1 Zoning in Glenayre

For those of you who missed it, The City held a special Committee of the Whole meeting at the Community Centre November 29. The public was welcome to give feedback, and then a petition signed by a group of neighbours was presented, as well as the results of the survey that the City Planning Department initiated in September.

The City has their work cut out for them striking a balance between maintaining the community of Glenayre while protecting people's investments in their property. To add to the complexity, the City has been tweaking rules around the general RS1 zoning and continues to make changes to bring them in line with other municipalities.

Are you concerned about traffic safety on our Glenayre streets? Please remember to stick to the 30 km/hr speed limit, and remind your guests/any contractors to do the same.

Glenayre Elementary has been taking steps to improve the situation around school-based traffic. The reality is that around school 'rush hour' (8:45am and 2:45pm) there will be a certain amount of traffic congestion around the school, a situation similar to all other schools. Glenayre Elementary has invested in additional signage related to traffic safety around the school, sent home notices to parents to inform them of traffic rules and safety, and has a weekly Walk on Wednesday program where students are encouraged to walk, cycle or car pool on Wednesdays to promote healthy living and to reduce traffic around the school.
