
Easter Egg Hunt

Glenayre Zoning Update

City Council has before it a very large update to the Zoning Bylaw to add some clarity and bring it in line with other municipalities in the GVRD. They hope to have this bylaw through legal review and a review by the Committee of the Whole in fairly short order so the final draft can be back before Council in February.

As it pertains to RS1 Zoning (most of Glenayre), there are changes to the definition of Floor Area Ratio, but other aspects such as setbacks, heights, and lot coverage looks to be the same.

At the January 23 Council Meeting, the motion to suspend any Glenayre-specific zoning until six months after the new general Zoning Bylaw is adopted was accepted.

Please consider subscribing to the City's electronic notifications for "Blueprint" to get notified of when the zoning discussion will be before council.
