## Focus on Seniors

Residents of single-family homes who are unable, due to temporary or permanent physical challenge, to safely move their solid waste bins to and from the curb may be eligible for the Set-out/Set-back Service offered by the Solid Waste Department of the City of Port Moody.

If you qualify for the "Set-out/Set-back Service", the solid waste truck driver will bring your bin from your home down to the curb for emptying; and then return the empty bin to your storage place.
