## RS1 Zoning in Glenayre

The City is trying to modernize their RS1 Zoning across the city in a way that will satisfy most people, hoping to avoid neighbourhood-specific zoning regulations.

Most recently, the City Planners have presented feedback from an open house to Council. The motion from Council's June 26th meeting is that the new Zoning Bylaw be referred to a Public Hearing on July 10; this was not yet in the City's calendar when this newsletter was published.
