Keep in mind that, even with the recent rains, at the time of publishing, Stage 2 residential lawn watering restrictions are in effect throughout the region: please keep you lawn watering to 1 hour per week, with even-numbered addresses permitted to water between 4am and 9am on Monday, Wednesday and Saturday, and odd-numbered addresses on Tuesday, Thursday and Sunday. Permits can be attained for new lawns which need more water.

Additionally, please remember that all dogs, big or small, are to be leashed while on school property at any time, as per the posted signs at the entrances
